





MISSION OF THE MONTH (MOM) Heeding God's Call -- Anti Gun Violence

The January Mission of the Month is Heeding God's Call—Delaware County Chapter. Heeding God's Call is a non-denominational faith based organization that addresses Gun Violence in the Philadelphia Area. The organization's principal activity is to identify Gun Stores that do not enforce background check and other mandated gun sale laws. It calls for Gun shop Owners to accept and enforce a 10 point Code of Conduct regarding gun sales. Another action that they support is the creation and public display of Memorials to the Lost which are gardens of T-shirts inscribed with the names of gun violence victims from the local community. Finally, this organization is a firm supporter of President Obama's recent executive order.

Heeding God's Call is a grass roots organization that, we believe, is made of solely of volunteers. The website is: http://heedinggodscall.org/ Tom G.

There are 2 manufacturers of these beautiful and expensive instruments: Malmark and Schulmerich. Lucky for us both are located just north of Philadelphia. Deciding which to purchase is simply a matter of personal choice. Both are outstanding, quality bells. So the question is just how much money are we talking about? A 3 octave set (with cases) runs \$9,950 (Malmark) to \$10,150 (Schulmerich). I would love to have conversation about how we can acquire our own set with anyone who is interested in this ministry continuing.
